

Course Title: Elect to Lead!
Course Dates: October 9, 10, and 11, 2008
Location: Portland Conference Center, Portland, Oregon

Credits: One or Two Credits
Credit Cost: \$70 for one credit or \$140 for two credits. Check or credit card accepted.

Clock Hours: 7.5 OR 15 hr.

Credit Requirements:

For one credit:

1. Participants will be asked to sign in each day at Credit/Clock hour table near registration.
2. Attend 7.5 hours or more of sessions, major speaker events or exhibits.
3. Keep a written log with brief notes of sessions attended and submit to your instructor, Sarah Applegate, (form available at clock hours table)
4. Write a 2-3 page paper (pass/fail) addressing how you will use the knowledge acquired to accept roles of leadership in your school or school community and submit to instructor via email by October 31, 2008
5. Submit notes electronically (scan and email), fax or mail.

For two credits:

1. Participants will be asked to sign in each day at Credit/Clock hour table near registration.
2. Attend 15 or more hours of sessions, major speaker events or exhibits.
3. Keep a log with brief notes of sessions attended and submit to your instructor, Sarah Applegate, (form available at clock hours table).
4. Write a 2-3 page paper (pass/fail) addressing how you will use the knowledge acquired to accept roles of leadership in your school or school community and submit to instructor via email by October 31, 2008
5. In addition to requirements for one credit (paper), create two (2) lesson plans using what you have learned at the conference.

ALL PAPERS MUST BE emailed by October 31, 2008. Failure to meet this deadline will result in a NC (no credit) grade issued. No incompletes will be issued.

Clock Hour Requirements:

1. Pick up clock hour information and list of sessions at the Credit/Clock hour table near registration.
2. Sign in when you pick up your information
3. Attend 7.5 or 15 hours of sessions, major speaker events or exhibits.
4. Initial next to each session you attended on the list of sessions.
3. Have clock hour supervisor sign your clock hour sheet before you leave conference.

Other Information:

1. Participants must complete all assigned work and submit on or before October 31, 2008. **There will be no exceptions to this.**
